How your information will be used by the Jack and Ada Beattie Foundation

- Validating any contract that we may enter into with you
- As part of our external auditing requirements

The Jack and Ada Beattie Foundation will not share copies of documentation sent to prove identity.

By signing and submitting your application form you give your explicit consent for us to use data relating to you for the purposes outlined above.

All data will be processed fairly and lawfully and will be held in an accurate manner. Measures will be taken to ensure the data is kept secure, and will not be held longer than necessary.”
