OUR PRIORITIES

The Jack and Ada Beattie Foundation holds an Open Grant Programme for individuals facing social injustice and inequality in the Midlands and London.

WHO CAN APPLY?

The Jack and Ada Beattie Foundation welcomes applications from all individuals facing social injustice due to an identifiable cause.

HOW MUCH CAN YOU APPLY FOR?

Financial support is administered through our 'Grants Scheme'. Grants available are between £500 and £5,000. The Jack and Ada Beattie Foundation will be looking to the applicant to demonstrate they can manage the amount they have applied for and the tangible results projected from the funding.

The Jack and Ada Beattie Foundation does not intend to engage in repeat funding of Individuals.

HOW TO COMPLETE THE APPLICATION FORM

Please complete all sections of the application form and mark "not appropriate" if that applies.

CONTACT DETAILS

Please give all contact details as requested. This will enable the Jack and Ada Beattie Foundation to keep accurate records of your organisation and help speed up the application process should we need to contact you by telephone or e-mail.

REFERENCE DETAILS

You must provide details of two independent referees. This should be two individuals who know you through a professional capacity. Each referee must be able to support your application.

Please note the referees stated will be asked to sign the following statement:

"I have known the applicant for at least one year. I have read the application and support this request for funding. I am willing to be contacted to discuss this application and at a later date to comment on the grant, if this application is successful".

CONTEXT DETAILS

These details will enable us to understand the context of your situation more fully and the social injustice you are facing.

FUNDING DETAILS

Information on the type and level of support you require will allow us to assess your application.

STATEMENT OF NEED

Please describe why you find yourself in this position of need. Please provide as many details of your financial status as appropriate.

DETAILS OF EXPECTED ACHIEVEMENTS AND RESULTS

The Jack and Ada Beattie Foundation will only support those applications with anticipated tangible and measured outcomes following our support. Please outline how our support can help you achieve identifiable results.

BREAKDOWN OF EXPENDITURE

If you are applying for a Grant, please outline the amount of money you need and where the funds are coming from (if you have applied to multiple funders). Please give a thorough breakdown of costs with timescales if appropriate. The Jack and Ada Beattie Foundation offers Grants in the region of £500-£5,000. We reserve the right to partially fund a project if we feel this is appropriate.
